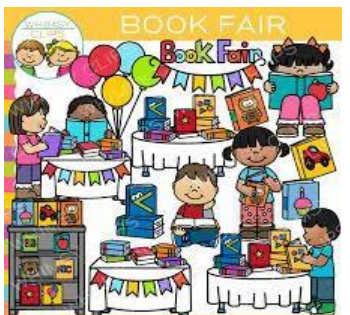
DATE: AUGUST 1 & 5 SAFAL EXAM DAY: FRIDAY

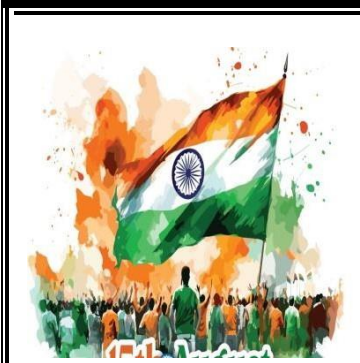
DATE:AUGUST 10 SPORTS DAY-CAVALIER'24 DAY: SATURDAY
