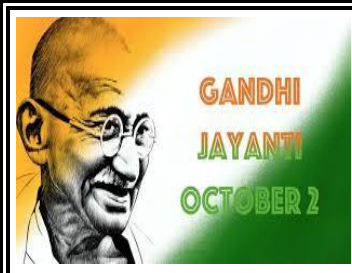

AIM: To honor the adorable bond between the grandparents and their grand children. It promotes intergenerational bonding, appreciation, and the sharing of wisdom and love across generations.

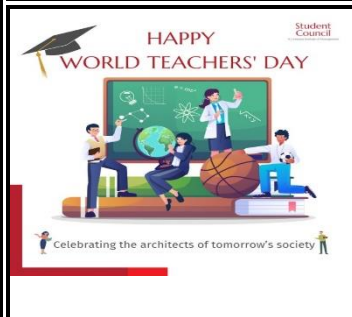
